- SweNanoSafe was established in 2016. Since 2019, the platform is hosted by the Institute of Environmental Medicine at Karolinska Institutet.
- The platform was commissioned by the Swedish Ministry of Environment, and it is managed by a steering committee of representatives from the Swedish Chemicals Agency (KemI) and from the Institute of Environmental Medicine (IMM) at KI.
- The platform aims to promote the safe handling of nanomaterials, to foster the dialogue between stakeholders, and support government agencies.

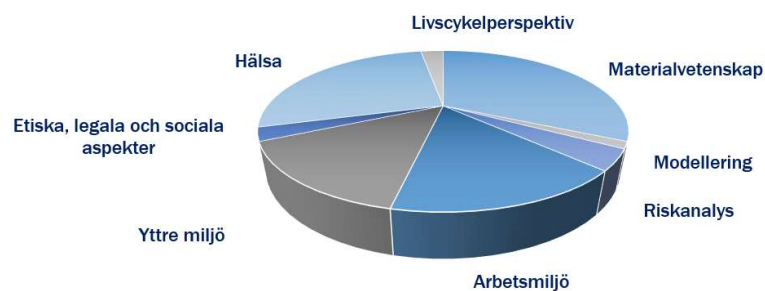
