

- The platform aims to promote the safe handling of nanomaterials, to foster the dialogue between stakeholders, and support government agencies.





Promote interdisciplinary networking in nanosafety research in Sweden and to provide experts to support various national and international bodies, e.g., OECD, CEN, ISO, EU.


